another human figure with a stick; on the extreme right there is a man with a large penis, wearing some form of headdress and holding a spear. There are also two simple human designs on Fig. 3 C.

The human figures in the Red Gorge are of particular interest because this is the only locality in the State, except at Eucola (HALL, McGowan and Guleksen, 1951, Figs. 16, 17, Pls. 26E) where they have been found.

On Figs. 3, 5 and 6 there are many representations of lizards. Some of these may represent goannas, although Figs. 3P, 5J and 6D certainly illustrate
