other species. Three engravings at Fig. 3E bear a resemblance to marine turtles. Other engravings, Figs. 3K, O, R and 6H, J, K, illustrate unidentified turtle-shaped creatures. Fig. 4E could depict either an echidna or a platypus. BASEDOW (1914, p. 202) who also illustrates this engraving makes the same suggestion.

There are examples of well-engraved human footprints at Figs. 4J; 5B, D, J, K, a distorted example at 5E and a number of engravings of bird and animal tracks on Figs. 4 and 5. There are also five sets of dingo tracks on Fig. 5A, M. In a previous publication (1962, p.98), the authors, who up to that time had not seen any representations of dingo footprints among the many thousands of rock engravings they had examined, suggested that this creature may not have
