- a Kire woman, seen in *Sivi* hamlet, Giri village; firewood in the bag behind her and a baby in the bag in front. Her clothing is a grass skirt.
- b Kire vegetable garden, located in a bamboo forest. The fence is made of bamboo poles. The crossed sticks bar the entrance and signify that a spell has been cast to make garden thieves sick.
- c Kire men sitting in the men's house (*ivanam*) in Tung village. Note the slit drums (*pan*) the stick (*ttor*) resting in each drum. The corner of the long communal bed is seen to the left. Traditional designs painted in imported pigments adorn the post.
- d Kire woman making a net bag. Her food is cooking in bamboo tubes over a smouldering fire. In her mouth is a cigarette made of newspaper and home-grown tobacco.
