

Little Andaman recorded in his report: "The first day we reached the bank of a river running south to north... of about forty feet wide with clear drinking water about three feet deep with excellent supply of fish and prawn." The Onge take advantage of this natural condition and for fishing, they explore all the different categories of waterways that exist in the island right from the open sea down to the marshy pools. In the fishing operation, they follow different methods permitted by their simple technological knowledge and local ecological conditions.
