

Report on an Archaeological Site on Mushu Island, Near Wewak, P.N. G.

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This site is situated on Mushu Island, one of the offshore coral islands north of Wewak. Its geographic position is between $3^{\circ}30'$ South and $143^{\circ}40'$ East. This island is presumed to have emerged during the second uplifting of the region (Prince Alexander range formation) in late Pleistocene, revealing its rock platform of mudstone on which marine materials had been built.
