<i>sumur</i>	well (<i>Indones.</i>)
<i>susunan</i>	title; ruler

<i>taksu</i>	spiritual 'power'
<i>taman</i>	leisure garden
<i>taure kesange</i>	purification ritual at the end of the 'dark half' of the year
<i>telaga</i>	pond; moat

<i>tenget</i>	'dangerous'; 'hot'; 'powerful'
<i>tirtha</i>	holy water
<i>titi gonggang</i>	'bridge' crossing a <i>telaga</i> in a temple (netherworldly connotation)

<i>tri wangsa</i>	'three groups of people'; caste
