

to admit that they could vary until several generations had passed. It must never be forgotten that from time immemorial the cephalic index has been looked on as an

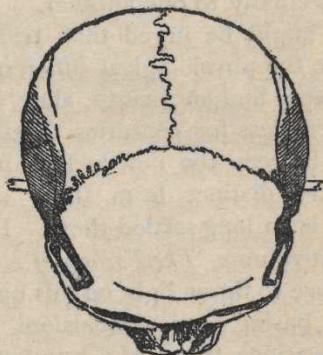
